Announcing the formation of the Licensed Site Remediation Professionals Association

The recent passage of the Site Remediation Reform Act (A-2962) by the New Jersey State Legislature will cause dramatic changes in the way that site cleanups in New Jersey will be overseen and administered. The act creates a Licensed Site Remediation Professional (LSRP) program and will establish a Licensing Board to govern the certification and conduct of LSRPs.

A coalition of consulting firms involved in site remediation projects in New Jersey has been active for nearly a year, representing the interests of site remediation professionals. This group has participated in hearings before the New Jersey State Legislature and in discussions with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.

Following the passage of the Site Remediation Reform Act, the **LSRP Association** was incorporated to support the interests of future LSRPs and to serve as a source of information for both LSRPs and other interested parties.

Committees are currently forming to help shape the Association. If you intend to become an LSRP, are interested in qualifying as an LSRP in the future or are concerned with the practice and development of site remediation in New Jersey, we invite you to get involved!
